2024 ANNUAL REPORT

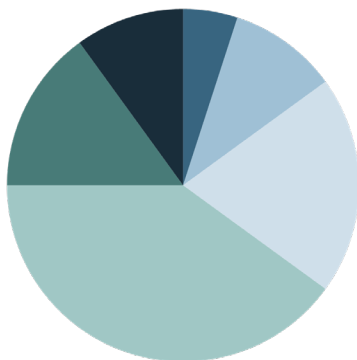

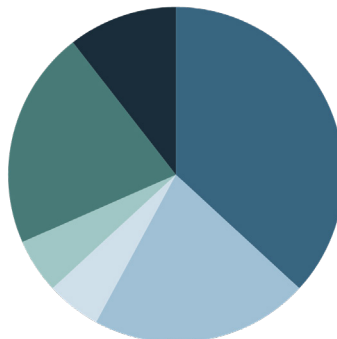
DEMOGRAPHICS OF YOUTH SERVED

2024 OUTCOMES

- 15 years old was the average age in 2024
- 94% of families participated in the Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) process
- 11.2 average family contacts per youth each month
- Each youth received a minimum of 1 hour of individual therapy per week
